It's Time to Speak Up!

Please make it your job to call your Congressman this week and ask them what they plan to do about the border wall and all the undocumented people pouring into San Diego County with no end in sight?

These elected officials need to hear from us...now.

If you are in Duncan Hunter's District you don't need to call him. Instead, call one of the Democrats listed. If you don't want to talk, then call after 5pm and leave your message.

We need a wall for many reasons...to stop:

- influx of illegal drugs, diseases
- Illegal immigrants from all over the world coming to San Diego with no place to live.
- abuse of children being used over and over to fake a family
- abuse of women being used as family members and to sell for the sex trade
- thousands of single young men with no jobs, no money, no skills, no English how will they live? Where will they get money and food? Crime?
