

Morris S. Hamather

1883 — 1952

Morris S. Hamather, 68, retired farmer, passed away Tuesday morning in Hubbard Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe, after a short illness.

Mr. Hamather was born on April 14, 1883, in Zurich, Ontario, and moved to Chandler township in 1906. On March 1, 1906, he was united in marriage to Rachel Bechler at Pigeon. They made their home in Chandler township until the spring of 1944 when they retired from the farm and moved to Elkton. Mrs. Hamather died on October 3, 1951.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Mervin Buschlen, of Elkton; a son Percy, of Flint; seven grandchildren, and one brother, Harry, of Bay City.
