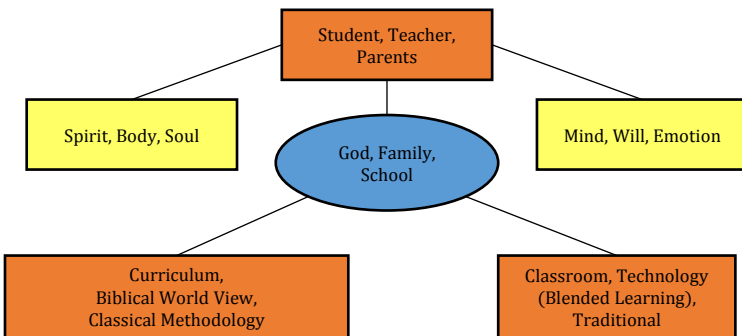

What’s in a Name?

In considering the name, Sonlight Bay Christian Consortium, LLC, *Sonlight* is rooted in John 8:12, where Jesus said, “I am the light of the world.” Jesus is simply the center of everything, the only true sustainable and enduring Source. It’s all about Him. A *bay* is an inlet, in this case referencing community or family. It’s cozy, larger than a cove but smaller than a gulf. There’s a natural degree of protection and security afforded it by the relationship of water to land. It’s not cut off from society but rather remains open so that its inhabitants may go out into the world, which we as reflections of His light, are called to do. Finally, a *consortium* may be defined as being any association, partnership, or union. Parents have been given the primary charge by God of being responsible for training up His children in the way He wants them to go (Gen. 18:19, Prov. 22:6, Eph. 6:4) so they may fulfill their ordained purpose for His glory and bless others along the way. As Christian educators, we come alongside the parents to work in a covenant relationship with them as “in loco parentis” in which their charge is temporarily transferred over to us. We then end up with nested consortiums with the core being God, family, and school:
