

In 2005, a dedicated group of volunteers founded the Autism Awareness Walk with hopes of raising the community's awareness about the prevalence of Autism Spectrum Disorders while also raising funds to benefit people with ASD. The community welcomed the Walk with open arms; as a result, it has grown each year. In 2010, the community showed such support for the Autism Awareness Walk that a decision was made to start a non-profit organization to ensure that all funds raised would benefit the local and surrounding communities with greater impact. In 2011, Autism Alliance of Northeastern NY was born, with a mission to empower individuals and families touched by Autism Spectrum Disorders through support and education.

At present, the Autism Awareness Walk is the sole source of support for Autism Alliance. Funds raised at the 2012 Walk were used to fund four workshops and five family events. Seven grants were provided to local agencies and/or schools. In addition, eight iPads for individuals with communication disorders were granted, and a lending library with autism-related literature was created.

One of the goals of Autism Alliance is to assist in connecting families with local resources. This pamphlet is one way we hope to do that. Autism is a spectrum disorder that requires a spectrum of resources. While no resource is perfect for every individual, we have strived to provide every possible resource that we are aware of in the greater Plattsburgh area so that you may find one or more that fit your needs.

If you have concerns about your child's growth and development, first discuss it with your pediatrician, then contact a representative in your area. They will accept qualified referrals and assist you in having your child evaluated to determine if he/she qualifies for Special Instructional, Speech/Language Services, Physical or Occupational Therapy, Counseling Services, Nutrition or Nursing Services, and/or Audiology services. Children under the age of 3 are evaluated through the Early Intervention Program; children ages 3 to 5 through the Preschool Special Education Program. There is no charge to families.

Early Intervention and Preschool services are provided at no charge to families.

# **Medicaid Service Coordination**

Medicaid Service Coordination (MSC) is a program designed to help people with developmental disabilities live independent and productive lives in the community according to their own dreams and desires. Through Medicaid Service Coordination, the individual and/or family works in a partnership with a qualified service coordinator to develop and maintain a personalized plan designed to meet individual needs and unique goals.

Medicaid Service Coordinators provide assistance and advocacy in many areas, including finding a day program, medical providers, residential placement, recreational activities, financial supports (such as SSI or food stamps), respite, community integration, etc.

In order to receive Medicaid Service Coordination, a person must meet the following criteria: Have a documented diagnosis of a developmental disability (such as an autism spectrum disorder); exhibit significant adaptive behavior skill deficits; demonstrate a need for ongoing and comprehensive service coordination; apply, qualify for, and enroll in Medicaid or a Medicaid Waiver program. Please note other criteria do exist. Contact a provider for more information.
