Minutes of September 10, 2019
Board Meeting @ Athens Village Hall

The Board met on September 10, 2019 at 5pm at the Village Hall. Meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Faulk, A Quorum was recognized.

The meeting was opened with Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance by Mayor Pro-Tem Faulk.

The floor was opened for any comments: Feamula Bradley with the LA Campaign for Tobacco-Free Living spoke on behalf of the proposed Ordinance No. 2019-3 in New Business and answered questions from the board.

The minutes of the August Board meeting was read: Alderman English made a motion to accept as read and Alderman Smock seconded the motion.

The financial report was presented to the Board, after reviewing the report was accepted.

New Business:

Resolution No. 11-2019 CWEF Grant FY 2019-2020 to have elevated water take cleaned, sterilized, painted, and an overflow pipe installed was presented to the Board and a motion was made by Alderman Smock to move forward with the Grant application and the motion was seconded by Alderman English.

Grant Resolution USDA Rural Development Community Facilities was passed allowing the Mayor to execute all necessary documents on behalf of the village and to accept the approved grant in the amount of \$39,000.00 for the purchase of a police vehicle and equipment.

Proposed Ordinance No. 2019-3 Prohibiting Smoking in all Workplaces and Public Places that was formally presented to the Board that was talked about in open comments by Tobacco-Free Living spokesperson Feamula Bradley.

With no other business on the Agenda the meeting was adjourned by Mayor Pro-Tem Faulk.
