

MWGA 2014 GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was called to order by President, Sheila Haynes.

A motion was made by Jeannie Parker to dispense with the reading of the 2013 minutes. It was seconded by Carolyn Barker, all were in favor.

Treasurer's Report

Sheila asked Lynn Harmount, Treasurer, to give the Treasurer's report. Reports were passed out for all in attendance. It was stated that Lynn and Sheila both met with Accountant, Lee West, to discuss all of the accounts of the MWGA. Under his direction, they have now reduced the 7 checking accounts to 2. They are the MWGA account and the Magnolia Scholarship Foundation account. These accounts have two separate tax ID numbers. It will be easier to keep up with 2 accounts instead of 7. A vote was taken by all club reps present, to accept Cannebrake for the 2015 4-Ball and Reunion for the 2015 Senior State Am. The vote passed.

Junior Tri-State

Sheila Haynes will be the captain of the girls Tri-State Tournament with Marilynne Burnside the co-captain. The tournament is the week of June 9th at Mystic Creek in Arkansas. There will be 8 girls on the Mississippi team. Golf Bags were purchased for the girls to use during the tournament, which have Mississippi embroidered on them.
