**Dr. Seuss** Dr. Seuss was born in 1904 in Springfield, MA. Although his name was Theodor Seuss Geisel, he used the pen names of Dr. Seuss, Theo LeSeig, and Rosetta Stone. Seuss wrote over 60 books during his career. He died in September 1991.
