Finally, ACTS Administration will be moving to Buschwood Park II situated at 3450 Buschwood Park Drive in Tampa. We hope to occupy the space by Spring 2024. With this move, the executive and administrative operations are strategically positioned for better proximity to our programs across Tampa Bay. I am grateful ACTS continues to be a

ACTS Clubhouse is Open

ACTS Clubhouse opened its doors to members on November 1. Currently, the ACTS Clubhouse, located at 201 E. Yukon Ave. in Tampa, is open three days a week – Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday - with the goal of opening more days in 2024. The ACTS Clubhouse held an open house for the public on November 9 with more than 30 people in attendance to learn about the services offered to adults seeking mental health recovery. Benefits of the Clubhouse Model for those with mental health disorders include:

- Yields higher rates of employment, longer job tenure, and higher earnings than traditional programs.
- Fewer and shorter hospital stays.
- Less involvement with the criminal justice system.
- Cost effective compared to other services for people recovering from mental illness.
