TOWN OF MARBLE ORDINANCE NUMBER 4 SERIES OF 1994

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COUNTY OF GUNNISON, STATE OF COLORADO, ESTABLISHING TOWN BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, the Town of Marble is a statutory town organized pursuant to Colorado Law, C.R.S. 31-1-101 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to establish the boundaries of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, ORDAIN:

Section 1. This ordinance may be cited as the "Town Boundary Ordinance."

Section 2. The Town of Marble boundaries are as described in the Map Number 307946 as recorded October 2, 1975, with the Gunnsion County Clerk and Recorder.
