

2010 Highlights

This year our grouse trial dogs had another great season. We were able to travel more this year and it was very fun, productive and rewarding. We made a strong showing in every state that we trialed in.

We started our championship campaign at the New York State Grouse Championship in September. Autumn Moon, owned by Jack Harang of Texas, won that championship with a record entry of 80 dogs. Next we traveled to Wisconsin for the Wisconsin Cover Dog Championship where Quail Trap Max, owned by Dave Hawk of Ohio garnered runner-up honors. From there we traveled on to Minnesota and won that grouse championship with Moss Meadow Traveler, owned by Ken Moss of Michigan. We finished up our championship trial season back in Michigan where Autumn's Hot Cocoa was named runner-up in the Lake States Championship for her owner Jack Harang. We were really proud of the fact that we were able to place four different dogs in the championships in the four states that we competed.

We also campaigned a few dogs in the companion stakes here in Michigan with success. We ran one open shooting dog stake in Michigan where Quail Trap Max earned first and Cooper Mountain Pepsi, owned by Mike Cooper of Ohio, was third. In the derby trials, Autumn's Double Dot, owned by Jack Harang, earned first in the derby stake at the Michigan Woodcock Championship and Dennis Keysor's Meredith's El DeGuello was Second at the Lake States open derby. Dale Hernden's flashy puppy Wrap It Up won two consecutive firsts in the puppy stakes.
