VENDOR APPLICATION

The 10th Annual Blueberry Festival will be held on **Saturday, April 24, 2021** at Donaldson Park, in historic downtown Avon.

We are pleased to invite you to participate in this event. However, several requirements exist for all potential vendors:

1. Food vendors may be highly limited and must not compete with the Rotary Club's offerings which includes chicken BBQ dinners. **Cost for food vendor is \$75, electric is additional \$10.**
2. Vendors are required to remain in operation until the close of the event.
3. Only original, handmade arts & crafts items are acceptable; no resale novelty items are permitted.
4. Only items approved on application will be permitted on the day of event. We try our best to eliminate an overly competitive vending environment we want everyone to have a successful experience.
5. Rental fee will be due in full at time of application. If you are not chosen to participate your monies will be refunded and if due to Covid-19 restrictions, the festival is cancelled.
6. The Avon Park Noon Rotary reserves the right to reject application or participation of vendors who do not abide by the established rules or Rotary's principles.

Each space is 10' x 10' and rents for \$45 - \$55 for a booth with electricity (120v).

Spaces with electricity are limited. All applications will be treated as first come, first served (based on approval). Please include a picture of your work if you will be selling handmade arts and/or crafts.

Covid-19 If Covid-19 safety protocols change, either by the City of Avon Park on its property at Donaldson Park, or the CDC national guidelines to protect the public, this event may have to be cancelled. The Avon Park Rotary has a March 1, 2021 deadline for a final decision. In the event of a cancellation of the Festival all fees will be quickly refunded by a check mailed to the address on the Vendor application. The festival is an outdoor event, social distancing between vendor slots will be used, and those in attendance will be strongly encouraged to wear face masks. Hand sanitizer will be available for public use. Unfortunately, there will not be a Kids Zone of activities this year for the safety of our children.
