

AnT Swim School Event Payment Conditions, Rules and Guidelines

Please note, by signing the form you agree to the outlined “Payment Conditions and Pool Rules”.

Payment Conditions (please read carefully)

Event rate is \$125 per hour with minimum 2 hour rental. The event services include

- 15 minutes courtesy setup time before the start time of the booked event slot,
- pool time with lifeguard on duty
 - pool opens at the start of the booked event slot
 - pool closes 15 minutes before the end of the booked event slot
- 15 min courtesy clean up time after the booked event slot with all guests having vacated the facility
 - If the extra clean up time is exceeded, an additional charge of \$25 per 15-minute increment (rounded up) is applied
- 1 lifeguard and 1 supervisor for a maximum of 50 event guests present in the facility.

If more guests are expected extra lifeguards are required at a cost of \$25 per each per hour (for each additional group of 25 guests an additional lifeguard is required).

The person hosting and responsible for the party is expected to be present at all times.

To book and secure the event slot, a deposit of \$50 is being charged at the time of booking with the full amount to be paid not later than 24 hours before the event (or the event is considered as canceled). The **deposit** of \$50 will be returned at the end of the event if the facility was vacated by all guests on time.

It is possible to extend the event time in 1-hour increments (at the cost of \$125) if the attending supervisor and lifeguard(s) agree to it.

Refund Policy and Cancellations

For cancellation up to 7 days before the event date the \$50 deposit will be fully refunded.

For cancellation within 7 days of the event the \$50 deposit will **not** be refunded.

For example, if a 2-hour event is being booked on 02/01 for the day of 03/31 the \$50 deposit will be charged at the time of booking.

In case the event is cancelled before 03/25 \$50 will be refunded. In case the event is cancelled after 03/25 no refund is being provided.

Sample Event

For example, an event is booked on 02/01 for 03/31 for the time slot 2:30 – 4:30 pm.

At the time of booking, 2 invoices will be created, one of \$50 which has to be paid immediately to secure the event and a second one in the amount of \$250 which has to be paid not later than 24 hours before the event date (or otherwise the event is being considered as canceled).

Event setup time starts at 2:15, pool opens with life guard on duty at 2:30 and closes at 4:15 and with all

guests to have vacated the facility by 4:45.

If the last guest leaves the facility before 4:45 pm the \$50 deposit is refunded.

If the last guest leaves the facility past 4:45 pm the deposit of \$50 will **not** be refunded.

Pool Rules

At all times follow the instructions of the AnT Swim school lifeguard and supervising personal.

The use of AnT Swim school equipment is not permitted.

Do not enter the pool if you suspect you have or have a communicable disease or an open cut or blister.

Wear family appropriate and clean swim attire only.

Shower before entering the pool or after use of toilet facilities.

Children in diapers must wear a reusable plastic pant with snug elasticized legs and waistband.

Diving is prohibited.

Spitting, spouting water from mouth or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.

No extended breath-holding or hyperventilation.

Only U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets and wearable foam flotation devices are allowed. Users must remain within arm's reach of an adult.

Do not run or engage in rough play in the pool area or bath rooms.

Diaper changing in the pool area is prohibited. Please use bath rooms.

Do not bring animals into the pool area.

Do not bring food, drink, gum or tobacco into the pool area.

Glass and shatter able items are prohibited in the pool area.

Toys, floating toys, water guns, etc... are allowed only at the discretion of the event supervisor and lifeguard(s).

General Information

It is highly recommended that all children wear life jackets or other approved floating devices. Parents are at all time responsible for the safety of their children. Lifeguards only add an extra layer of safety.

A (limited) number of life jackets are available (at no cost).

6 large Benches for seating and 3 small tables to setup food are available
