

Computer Printing Tip:


Have you ever wanted to print out only one page of a bulletin? Here's how it works on a PC:

At the top of the screen, <u>do not click</u> on the printer picture. Instead click on the word FILE, then click on PRINT.

After the PRINT box shows, select from the Pages To Print options.

ALL = prints every page in the document

CURRENT PAGE = prints only the page that the cursor is on
