You pay one low class fee per class but get to compete under both judges!!!

Registration Requirements:

Horses must be registered with NAPHA or the PHAC. Horses must be entered based upon the current, registration papers, registered owner, full registered name & number. Male horses 4 years of age & older must be registered as a stallion or gelding. Registration papers indication "male" will not be considered acceptable registration papers. The only exception will be male horses entered in Colts 3-4 in Bozal. Spayed mares may not be shown as a breeding mare.

Vendors

There are nice spaces available surrounding the show arena. Fill out Vendor Application and submit as instructed by the form.

FUNDS & FINANCES

Payment

At this time the Fiesta del Norte only accepts cash and check.

Late Fees

A late charge of \$5 will be added to each Entry Fee after July 29. This charge will also be assessed on incomplete entries after July 29 (e.g. those without copies of registration papers or full payment), regardless of when the entry was received.)

Championship Classes, Champion of Champions, Best Gaited, Best Bozal

Horses qualifying for these classes will be automatically entered and charged a fee. Please notify the show office if you do not wish to enter the appropriate Championship Class, otherwise fees will be charged.

Refunds and Substitutions

Valid, written veterinary excuse required for refunds!

Pre-entered horses: Class and stall fees refundable.

At show: Refunds for pre-entered classes ONLY, if the horse has not entered them. If a horse is entered by July 30 but then is unable to perform, another horse may be substituted at no additional fee.

INFORMATION CONCERNING YOUR HORSE

ALL horses are required to have a Health Certificate issued within 30 days of the show stating that your horses are in good health and free from disease. You must also have a negative Coggins (EIA) test for each horse within one year prior to the show.

STALL/ BARN INFORMATION

Barn Check In

Regular Stall check-in begins Friday, August 10 at 8 A.M.

Each horse must be stalled separately, with the exception of mares with nursing foals. No changes shall be made from assigned stalls without the Barn Manager's permission. Upon arrival, there will be a stall layout sheet posted on the window of the show office to locate your stalls.

****EARLY ARRIVALS ARE NOT ALLOWED WITHOUT CONTACTING AURA AUSTIN at (507) 380-7085.** This is important so your stalls and camping spot will be unlocked with bedding and ready for you!

SATURDAY NIGHT

After the classes end for the day, get a bite to eat then join us for mingling at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday night in the barn. Bring your own beverages and chairs. If you don't have any, don't worry, come anyway! If you are new to the show and don't know many people, call Aura (507) 380-7085 so she can show you around and introduce you to other Peruvian Horse lovers. All are welcome!!! This is a great time to visit with the judges!

OPTIONAL: SPECIAL TACK AND ATTIRE FOR ALL CLASSES

To promote participation and allow competitors to try something other than the normal white attire, we have developed guidelines for other-color clothing in any class. This is NOT mandatory, rather an option for those who would like to try something different!

IF you Decide to ride with alternative Tack and Attire, Please follow the below specified rules:

Approved clothing colors: Black, shades of grey (charcoal to light); browns (dark to tan/beige, khaki); shades of muted greens (olive to hunter); small pinstripes; light blue or dark navy; burgundy (no bright reds); white, creams, ivory.

- Hat: Must be of Peruvian type as currently outlines in NAPHA rules unless matching an attire such as Western.
- No ponchos: Blazer or Suit Style Vest MUST be worn, if wearing alternative attire.
- Boots & Belt: In colors and type as currently outlined NAPHA rules. Boots allowed to be worn outside of pants. Polinas allowed in same range of colors.
- Alternative color vests/jackets allowed in colors as outlined above.
- Shirts: Collared, long-sleeved shirt in white or colors as outlined above,
- Slacks/Pants: must be sufficiently long enough to cover ankle and boot tops unless the boots are being wore outside of the pants. Jeans in above solid colors. Please, no casual looking blue jeans.
- Split skirts or sidesaddle aprons for women: As provided for in NAPHA rules, also in above colors.
- Scarves & Ties: Traditional white scarf, Peruvian style; bolo tie or Western crisscross tie, in above outlined colors: or necktie & brooch.
- Spurs are optional and must be of the Peruvian type if used, unless to match other tack style.

Western, Plantation, English etc. type tack and attire is allowed

Don West Saddle Tack Exception: Don West Saddles may be used.

Special Side Saddle Tack Exception: A side saddle of appropriate type may be used by a female rider in any bit class. Not permitted for use with bozal horses. A white safety apron that covers the stirrup leg to the ankle is allowed or of a color to coordinate with outfit.

Bareback: Bareback pads allowed.

IF you decide to ride in traditional gear:

Peruvian bridle and bit, halter, eye covers, saddle and corona, crupper and tail covers and stirrups; wooden or leather stirrups. Pellon and Peruvian type spurs are optional.

Bozal Classes: Peruvian bozal, halter, eye covers, saddle and corona, crupper and tail cover and stirrups; leather stirrups are acceptable. (No pellon, poncho, or spurs.)

RULES AND SHOW STANDARDS

NAPHA Rules: The Fiesta del Norte Peruvian Horse Show is operated in accordance with the current official RULES AND REGULATIONS OF HORSE SHOWING AND PERUVIAN PASO BREED STANDARDS of the NORTH AMERICAN PERUVIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for a knowledge of, and is subject to, these NAPHA rules. NAPHA Show Rules can be downloaded from the Fiesta show Web site www.PeruvianHorseShow.com under the Forms page.

The 2018 Fiesta del Norte/Northern Lights Peruvians DOUBLE show is approved by the North American Peruvian Horse Association (NAPHA). This show will earn a minimum of double points for NAPHA Awards if the recorded owner(s) of the horse is/are a current NAPHA member at the time of the show—Year end Awards—Medallon de Plata, High Point Performance Horse/Gelding, Zone 3 and Lifetime Awards—Medallon de Oro, Medallon de Bronze and the new NAPHA Lifetime Award –Medallon de Diamonte. Everything is being done to conduct the show on the highest possible plane and for the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudication officials to be found are selected, the judge by vote of the Fiesta exhibitors of the previous show, and he/she will place awards upon the horses as they see them presented in the arena, without regard to previous records of performance. Anyone competing in the Amateur Performance Division is required to have a written Amateur Declaration on file with NAPHA. Forms will be available at the Show Office or may be downloaded from www.napha.net. The Fiesta del Norte Peruvian Horse Show is conducted under the drug-free rules of NAPHA and will do random testing. No Prueba Funcional.

New NAPHA rules pertaining to Amateur/Professional and Novice rules:

Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Amateurs" only must have a signed NAPHA Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA. Amateurs must file annually. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur if after their 18th birthday they have not engaged in any of the activities identified in PART X Glossary of Terms, Section 10 Professional, of

the NAPHA Show Rules. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under NAPHA rules must be listed on the NAPHA website as an Amateur or have signed a NAPHA Amateur Declaration and filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. See PART X GLOSSERY OF TERMS for complete definition of Amateur and Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules.

Novice Classes:

Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Novices" only must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the NAPHA. Novices must file this form annually. An exhibitor (18 years and older) can compete in the Novice Division for a period of 3 years. If the Novice, at the end of 3 years has not competed in more than 8 NAPHA approved shows during that period they may extend the time period for another 3 years (double shows count as one show). However, if at any time, a Novice competes and wins a Champion title in gait, breeding, or performance (any other Division above the level of Novice) they will be immediately excluded from competing in the Novice Division at future shows.

Owner:

The name on the certificate of ownership, issued by the NAPHA, AAOBPPH, PPHRNA, OR PHAC, and their minor children. If the horse is owned by a ranch, corporation, or a family trust the individuals' names must be registered with the NAPHA. Lessees will not be allowed to show leased horses in classes where only the owner is allowed to ride.

GENERAL RULES

Judge's Authority:

The Judge has the authority to place any horse in whatever position he/she thinks the merit of the horse justifies. Any exhibitor desiring to discuss his placing with a judge must FIRST obtain permission from the Show Steward.

Cone Spacing:

It will be requested of the judges to keep the spacing between cones in the performance division classes to be at least 8 feet apart.

Post Entries:

Post Entries will be allowed. The Show Secretary will accept class entries up to 3 classes prior to the class for which entry is requested. Past Champions & National Champion of Champions MUST be pre-entered by July 29, 2018.

Conduct and Safety:

The Fiesta del Norte/Northern Lights Peruvian Horse Show expects the highest standard of ethics from its exhibitors and those persons under their authority and will tolerate no act of disobedience or discourtesy toward any show official, under penalty of disqualification or expulsion from the show. Courtesy will be shown to fellow exhibitors and the viewing public at all times. Cruelty to any horse, by any person at

this show will NOT be tolerated. Exhibitors shall at all times take whatever steps are necessary to protect themselves, their horses, and the viewing public. Please be especially careful in the warm-up arena and gate areas. SUPERVISE YOUR JUNIORS!

Ring Admission Steward:

The Ring Admission Steward shall call to the attention of the Show Steward or the Show Veterinarian any entry which does not, in his/her opinion, conform to the NAPHA showing requirements regarding hoof length, appearance, tack attire, and soundness. The Show Steward and/or Veterinarian (where needed) shall investigate and handle such matters in accordance with the NAPHA rules.

Drugs and Artificial Appliances

The use of artificial appliances and forbidden substances shall be prohibited in all phases of horse exhibition in or out of the show ring. The exhibitor is to advise the Horse Show Committee or Secretary of all drugs administered within 72 hours prior to or during the event (*in writing*). This information is to be made available for inspection by anyone interested. No horse shall be eligible for competition in any class if it has been administered a forbidden substance, i.e., any stimulant, depressant, tranquilizer, or local anesthetic which might affect the performance of the horse. Any horse entered in a class is subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian.

Call to Classes

Classes will be called promptly and with advance notice before each preceding class enters the ring. Three minutes will be allowed after the gate is opened.

Tack Change

If a tack change is required, a request in writing must be submitted to the secretary at least 3 classes in advance of that class. This provides an additional four minutes for a total of seven minutes.

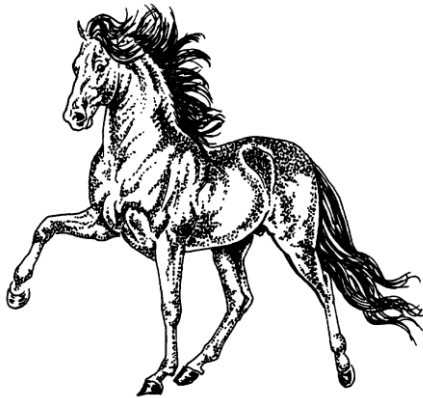

First and second place horses in qualifying classes will be automatically entered in their respective Championship Classes. If you do not wish to show in the Championship classes you will need to scratch with the show secretary.

Please Note: All **returning** Champions, Champion of Champions and National Champion of Champions **MUST BE pre-entered & pre-paid by July 29, 2018.**

The judges will be chosen by club vote every year.

Barrida of Champions

High Point Novice, High Point Crystal Horse, High Point AOTR, Best Bozal, Best Gaited and all Champion of Champions are welcome to ride in the Barrida of Champions following the last class of the show.

Traveled the Farthest?

We know traveling with horses can be a drag (no pun intended)! Because of your commitment to the Fiesta show we want to show you our appreciation by providing awards for the person or ranch who travels the farthest to get to the Fiesta del Norte/Northern Lights Double Show! Hitch up the trailer, we'll see you there!

Novice Division

See the new NAPHA novice rules above. Novice riders, we encourage you to also enter in the other amateur classes and Amateur Owner to Ride classes.

AOTR Division

There is a High Point AOTR award. The amateur owner may ride the same horse in all three of the AOTR classes to compete for the AOTR high point award.

Juniors

\$20 Stall for Junior's Horse! You pay for the bedding and entry fees but the stall is only \$20. The Junior simply must enter in three of the qualifying classes on the same horse, either: 4,5, 18, 19, 26, 27, 38, 39

Junior High Point/ Reserve High Point: **All** Juniors should report to the arena for these awards.

Juniors Tack: Retrancas are prohibited, baticola is required and floran is optional. **Helmets are strongly recommended and are required for Juniors younger than age 13.**

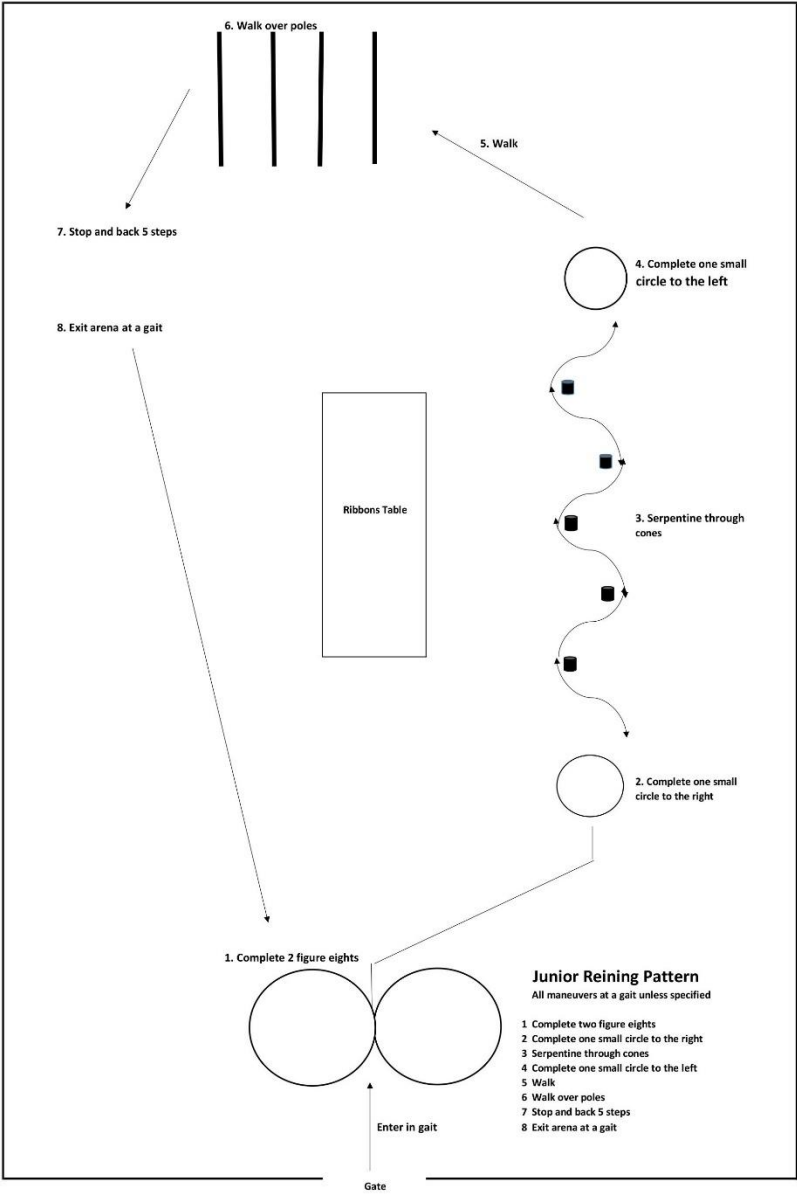
Juniors must be at least 15 years of age to show stallions.
