### Lakewood Forest Civic Association Board Meeting Minutes August 3, 2021

#### Minutes

#### **Treasurer Report**

The money market account has a balance of \$9,497.56 and the 12-month CD has a value of \$5,569.76. In comparing our budget to actual expenses to date, we have a positive balance of \$6,321.

We received \$120 in membership renewals this month. A total of \$20,250 has been received to date this year.
