### Opening

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, November 8, 2021 in the shop behind the township hall building. Bill Siegel, township trustee chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He led the Pledge of Allegiance and stated that the meeting is being recorded.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel, Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole.
- Bill Siegel stated that the minutes for the Regular Meeting on October 11th, 2021 are available in the back of the room
- **Dave Cole made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 11, 2021, Regular Trustee meeting. Bill Bogantz seconded the motion and it passed with YES votes.**

- Update on debt to state for 2015 and 2016 – Melodie filed the state form so instead of being over \$3000 the debt is \$637.55 due to penalties, interest and filing late fees

### New Business

- OPWC on-line payment – OPWC is wanting to have us move to on-line payments.  
**Bill Bogantz made a motion to allow the Fiscal Officer to make OPWC payments for the township on-line. Dave Cole seconded the Motion. Vote: Bill Siegel – NO, Bill Bogantz – YES, Dave Cole – YES. The motion passed.**

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- Mailbox – Postal workers have put notes in mailbox that the approach to their mailbox needs attention and pointed them to ask the township to fix it. Bill Bogantz will look into seeing who is responsible for the mailbox approach – is it the land owner or the township / county / etc.?
- MORE Grant – Bill Bogantz described the internet option with T-mobile. It is made up of both a hardware cost of \$650 and a monthly fee of about \$50. The MORE Grant is for \$500 so it would cover most of the hardware.

**Bill Siegel made a motion to apply for the MORE Grant to cover the hardware costs for providing real-time security of the township property. Dave Cole seconded the motion. It passed with all YES votes.**
