FCCLA Distracted Driving Grant and Local Business Support

Three students, Kinsey Anderson, Emmie Fishell, and Sophia Handran have been working on a project to increase awareness concerning Distracted Driving Prevention. They received grant funding from the Montana Department of Transportation for an Arrive Alive Simulator Presentation and money to purchase wrist bands, lip balm, and they designed a coloring book for younger passengers to be aware of Safe Driving Skills. They received three separate grants for \$3500 (the simulator), \$700 (wrist bands and lip balm with prevention messages) and \$600 (coloring books and guest speaker).

The Arrive Alive Team was interested in adding Drunk and Drugged Driving with the simulator, as well. They needed more funding and a big Thanks to Leif Handran for organizing additional funding with Nemont, Pro Coop, Independence Bank and Daniels Sheridan Federal Credit Union to fund the full session of Arrive Alive. Thank you for your support of increasing awareness to prevent an accident with our youth! The Arrive Alive Team will be here one day during the week of February 20th . They will also be presenting at Medicine Lake, Plentywood, Glasgow, and Poplar.

We are very fortunate to have received MT DOT funding for each school for the Distracted Driving portion and with the support of our local businesses we will be reaching out to other local schools to have them join in the presentation. Scobey will be inviting Opheim to participate and the other schools are working on surrounding school involvement as well!
