As I write this report, it is now a week after the Pure Stock Muscle Car Drag Race. Thank you for everyone who came out to help. We are like a well-oiled machine now. Everyone seems to know what to do, and the racers and spectators alike comment how well-run the event is! Dennis, Lyndon and I certainly could not do it without you!

The car count was down a bit this year to 109. We had 131 last year. Even so, the racing was very close, so much so that the track owners took notice. Pontiacs made a strong showing. Brand breakdown went like this: Chevy - 25, Pontiac - 22, Mopar - 21, Buick - 14, Ford & Mercury - 12, Olds - 7, Studebaker - 5, and AMC - 3. Spectator count was about the same as last year, about 500 on Friday and 1000 on Saturday (does not include racers and Pontiac club members). The pit-side stands looked pretty full-on Pontiac saturday!

The weather was about as good as we could ask for. Sun and clouds, with temperatures in the low to mid 70s each day.

Next year will be our 30th annual event! It's hard to believe we've been doing this for so long. I hope we will have many more.
