## How to win the prizes!

### How does the Silent Auction work?

All the Silent Auction items will be on display in the Link and entrance of the church the day of the dinner. You are encouraged to saunter around, look at what's offered and see what interests you. If you are having dinner, feel free to take a gander before or after dinner. But also know that you do not need to have the fabulous dinner to participate in the silent auction or raffle. We'd love to have you participate in all three, but feel free to pick and choose.

#### How does the bidding work?

Each item, gift basket, or Celebration will have a bid sheet attached to it. We have two types of bidding this year. For gift baskets, it is a true auction bid and you will be bidding against others. At the end of the dinner, if you have put in the highest bid, you "win" that item. For Celebrations, it's first come, first served. Sign-up and you are in. The bidding starts at 11:00 am and ends at 2:30 pm.

# Do I need to stay until the end of the dinner to claim my winnings?

You do not. Most people come and go. We'll be sure to notify you if you win anything after the dinner if you are no longer there. We encourage people to pick up their items and turn in the donations quickly after the dinner, usually within a week. If you are able to stay until the end of the dinner, claim your bid winning items then. We also hold the raffle right at the end of the dinner. But don't worryif you are not there and your raffle ticket is called, we will get in touch with you afterwards.

#### Can I still get raffle tickets?

Yes, you can. Anyone can get raffle tickets, and you don't have to be a member of St. C's. Notify Michael or Mary at

## Silent Auction Baskets

You assemble the basket with the theme of your choice and donate it to the Silent Auction. How about a basket "For the cook"?
