The Art of Racing In The Rain By Garth Stein

A heart-wrenching, funny and ultimately uplifting story of family, love, loyalty, and hope, The Art of Racing in the Rain is a beautifully crafted and captivating look at the wonders and absurdities of human life...as only a dog could tell it. Enzo knows he is different from other dogs: a philosopher with a nearly human soul (and an obsession with opposable thumbs), he has educated himself by watching television extensively, and by listening very closely to the words of his master, Denny Swift, an up-and-coming race car driver. Through Denny, Enzo has gained tremendous insight into the human condition, and he sees that life, like racing, isn't simply about going fast. Using the techniques needed on the race track, one can successfully navigate all of life's ordeals.

On the eve of his death, Enzo takes stock of his life, recalling all that he and his family have been through. Enzo comes through heroically to preserve the Swift family, holding in his heart the dream that Denny will become a racing champion with daughter Zoë at his side. This novel has been translated into 23 languages and it's also headed for a movie adaptation thanks to "Grey's Anatomy" actor Patrick Dempsey, with a projected release in 2012.

April 19 – Cutting for Stone by Abraham Verghese

A compelling read that is richly written, this novel shows how history and landscape and accidents of birth and death conspire to create the story of a single life. It is an unforgettable tale of love and betrayal and forgiveness. A medical romance —surgery meets history. The writing is graceful, the characters compassionate and the story is full of wisdom.
