

## ***New to 2020!***

***Goals!*** A primary goal of the CRCA is to allow a first place winner to at minimum win their entry fee back (excluding \$1K, \$5K, Nov NPBS classes)

***New Class!*** We are offering a 4-year old Incentive Class with an earnings limit of \$5,000 on the horse for Open and Non-Pro at time of show.

You must enter up in another Derby Class.

The incentive will have added money, and will be offered at all 2020 shows.

***New Entry!*** Single entry fee for both Open and Int LAE, and split for go rounds and final payouts is 75% Open, 25% Intermediate. The Ltd Open Derby or Futurity riders do NOT have to enter the Open. The class runs by itself.

***AQHA!*** We will hold AQHA Classes at every show, and we will separate AQHA Junior and Senior classes if there are 3 or more entries in each class.

***New Show!*** We have resurrected the Colorado Futurity!

It will be held in October in Pueblo.

To help avoid confusion the horseshow in August in Montrose has been renamed the West Slope Pre-Futurity.

***Class Update!*** The Pro Am Box class will continue forward with only eligible entries. CRCA will work to schedule practices as able for other participants.

***New Policy!*** A large part of the horseshow cost is the cattle expense, and in an effort to keep your horseshow costs down, we are instituting a new policy for cancelling an entry.

We now have two deadlines to be aware of – an **Entry Deadline** and a **Cattle Deadline** (a few days later).

If a 3-event participant cancels after the Cattle Deadline, there is a charge of \$200 per entry.

There is no charge to cancel a horseshow class, or to enter after any deadline.

If a 3-event participant enters after the Cattle Deadline, they will be put at the bottom of the herd draw with used cattle and first on the rein/fence work.
