

We will be giving a demonstration using the AccuQuilt Cutter.

In the Workshop you will be able to use the GO! cutter. You can bring your sewing machine if you want to make the fabric bowls, put blocks together or for appliqué.

Fabric Supply list:

1 Large Fabric Bowl ~ You will need 2 - 12" square of Fabric & Batting

1 Small Fabric Bowl ~ You will need 2 - 10" square of Fabric & Batting

To Cut 2½" strips (Binding) ~ You will need 8½ wide WOF to WOF this will cut 3 strips. If you want more strips bring 2 or 38½ wide WOF. Just bring some fabrics if you want to make some Pot Holders and or different blocks.

- 1 pound 93% lean ground 1 (15-ounce) can pinto turkey beans, firsted


 Ziabbapuons chii puwder 5 cups thinly sheed
- 46 leaspoon salt, divided.
- I avocado, pitted
 to dup nonfat plain Greek
- vigirt 1% cups crumbled unsalted tortilla chips.
- Europprepared salsa

- 1 medium tomato, chapped

Heat oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Add turkey, chili powder and ¼ temporon salt. Cook, stirring and breaking up lumps, until cooked through, about 5 minutes. Meanwhile, mash avocade, yegurt and the remaining 1/4

teaspoon salt in a small bowl with a fork until smooth. Transfer the turkey and any juice from the pan to a serving bowl. Layer chips, salsa, beans and lettuce over the tur
