How to Sell Your Pool Membership

It is the responsibility of the owner of the membership to sell/transfer it if they no longer wish to use the membership. Until they do so, the owner of the membership is responsible for the payment of the annual dues. Due date is April 1st.

Members can utilize several of the free on-line methods of advertising their membership for sale such as:

- Craig's List
- NextdoorHiddenbrook.com
- HerndonPatch.com

Members may also utilize community forms of advertisement such as:

- bulletin boards such as you might see in Panera Bread or local grocery stores
- talk to neighbors and friends to see if they know of anyone looking for a membership
- contact new families who may have recently purchased a home in the neighborhood and ask if they're interested.

Remember, the swim and tennis club is open to anyone to join and is not restricted to Hiddenbrook HOA members only.

Members may also convey their swim and tennis membership with the sale of their home subject to the following restrictions:

- The new owner must be made aware that there are separate dues which they will be responsible for if they accept the membership.
- The transfer paperwork must be completed at or before for the sale of the home and, the transfer papers must be immediately submitted to the club in order for the transfer to be validated.
- If the paperwork is not submitted, the membership will remain in the original owners name and as such, they will still be responsible for the dues payment.

Although the club is not responsible for selling or assisting members in selling their memberships, we will provide contact information for any current members who wish to sell their membership. **This exchange of information will only occur if the club has sold all of its memberships.** This information will not be prioritized in any particular order, and potential buyers may call one or all the contacts on the list. In order for a member to be added to the list, their dues must be paid in full for the season. Enclosed in the annual bill there will be an additional check box to notify the club that you are interested being added to the list. This should be returned with the annual dues payment so that you can be added to the list.

Lastly, the seller sets the price for the membership. The membership prices are based upon supply and demand and as such, members may be able to get more for the membership than they originally paid for it or, they may have to sell it for less than they paid for it. The price to purchase a membership through the club is set by the Hiddenbrook Board of Directors and may change from year to year.

Waste Management – Everybody's Job

Although the Fairfax County Solid Waste Management department sends out a flyer every year, we thought it would be helpful to reiterate some of the important information from this flyer in case you didn't receive one or your copy was lost or discarded. With spring just around the corner, this information should be helpful every day or when doing your spring cleaning around the house.

Fairfax County Code requires household trash and recyclables be collected weekly. This code also requires that customers be provided with containers that are water tight and insect-proof with tight-fitting lids. All customers are provided a gray rolling cart for trash and a blue rolling cart for recycling. Carts should not be loaded to more than **100 pounds** and personal trash containers should not weigh more than **50 pounds** each. Hiddenbrook Community solid waste is collected by Fairfax County and the cost of that service is added to our individual real estate tax bills. Leaf collection is handled and billed in the same manner. In an effort to get solid waste collection off the Top 10 list of most dangerous jobs in America, Fairfax County will be adding more lighting, more reflective striping, and more of the **Slow Down to Get Around** logos on their trucks.

<u>Schedule</u>: Trash is picked up on Thursdays. Regular trash, recycling, brush and bulk collection services are provided on all holidays except Christmas Day. Service may be suspended in severe weather or emergency situations.

Set-out Instructions: Carts should be set out before 6:00 am, approximately 3 feet apart (12 inches at a minimum), and at least 6 feet away from vehicles and other personal property where possible. Carts must be placed at the curb with handles facing the house and the lids must close tightly. No trash may be left at the curb for more than 10 days.

<u>Placement</u>: The following are common sense and courteous methods we would like you to follow:

- Trash should not block sidewalks or storm drains
- > Trash cans should not be placed at curbside until the evening before scheduled pickup
- All trash should be contained safely so no one, especially county staff, is injured
- Multiple items should be bundled and not dropped loosely at the curb so they do not scatter

- > All food items should be contained so animals cannot invade and scatter them around
- Standard pickup will **not** include large unwieldy items...arrange for special collections
- Trash cans should not remain at the curb after pickup for more than one day
- Trash cans should be stored out of sight between scheduled pickups

Special Collections: For items too large to collect with a standard garbage truck, our base service includes **5** <u>free</u> special collections per fiscal year (July 1 – June 30). You must schedule special collections in advance and the cut off time for next day pickups is 2:30 PM the day before our collection day. Special collection piles are limited to:

- 12 cubic yards of material (a pile about 5 feet x 6 feet x 10 feet)
- Piles of heavy/dense materials are limited to 6 cubic yards
- Materials must be no bigger than 6 feet long and 6 inches in diameter
- > They will need 20 feet of clearance on all sides of the debris

Megabulk: The Megabulk Program is designed to help remove whole trees and large loads of waste including construction and demolition waste. A Megabulk cost estimate is valid for 10 days based on items placed at the curb. The minimum charge is \$60.00 but prices may vary depending on the volume of materials. Materials left at the curb for more than 10 days are considered abandoned and Fairfax County may remove them at your cost of \$250 plus actual labor, equipment and disposal costs.

<u>Curbside Recycling:</u> The following materials may be placed in wheeled recycling carts:

- Cartons Mixed Paper & Cardboard Metal Cans Foil & Glass Bottles Jugs Pails Bucket Tubs – Lids & Caps (These items may be mixed in your wheeled recycling bin)
- > No clamshell containers either Styrofoam or clear plastic should be placed in the bin

<u>Yard Debris</u>: Pick up for these items is March 1st – December 24^{th.} Yard waste must be placed at the curb in separate containers, in bags or tied in bundles (no longer than 4 feet) and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Brush must not exceed more than 6 inches in diameter and more than 4 bundles require a special collection.

<u>Hazardous Waste and Used Electronics</u>: Take these items to the county's solid waste facilities at 4618 West Ox Road, Fairfax, or 9850 Lorton Road, Lorton. These will be processed at no charge.
