RULES ROUND-UP

Love 'em or hate 'em,

*Rules & Regulations: **HURRICANE PREPARATIONS***

Each dwelling unit owner...during the hurricane season must prepare his Residence ... by:
B. Removing all furniture, plants and other movable objects from his lawn, terrace and/or porch.

C. Any dwelling unit owner failing to make hurricane preparations and/or making improper preparations shall be held responsible for any damage done to the property of OTHER unit owners, and/or to common areas resulting from such failure.

... D. no loose articles shall be left on terraces and/or porches during the hurricane season

We are in the busiest segment of Hurricane Season. Time to take inventory all of the items outside your home. Do you have lawn chairs stacked on your patio or at the side of the house that you seldom use? Move the extras into the garage or screen room now. Ladders, rakes, flower parts, shovels, gas containers, extra garbage cans and all other tools should be stored indoors all the time. So if you have left any these items outside take 30 minutes today, move them all inside. Be High Wind Ready.

It only takes a thunderstorm, Tropical wave or Tropical Depression to send 30- 50 mile an hour winds through The Meadows. If your snowbird neighbor has loose items outside contact them to let them know you are concerned that loose items stored outdoors will become flying objects causing dangerous and severe personal and property damage. To maintain the property values and beauty of The Meadows everything that can be, should be stored in the garage for our community's safety and beauty.

TO MAINTAIN THE PROPERTY VALUES AND BEAUTY OF THE MEADOWS EVERYTHING THAT CAN BE, SHOULD BE STORED IN THE GARAGE FOR OUR COMMUNITY'S SAFETY AND BEAUTY.

The Census is coming! Census forms will be mailed to every household in March 2010 and Census Day is April 1, 2010.

The U.S. Constitution requires a national census every 10 years. The form takes about 10 minutes to complete and asks questions such as: age, name, gender, race, ethnicity, relationship & whether the householder owns or rents.

It's Safe to Complete the Census

- No documents – no problem. Don't be afraid to be counted! Census forms are completely confidential for 72 years and cannot be shared with anyone, including welfare and immigration agencies.
- No court of law, not even the President of the United States, can access your individual responses.
- Census workers are highly motivated to protect your answers – they are subject to a \$250,000 fine and/or a five-year prison term for disclosing any information that could identify a respondent or household.

Census Results Determine Funding for Community Projects

- Federal and state governments use census data to allocate billions of dollars in funding for local community programs, including funding for education, public safety, housing and community development, libraries, transportation, roads and bridges, job training, health care and other human services.
- Funds flow to communities who conduct the most complete and accurate count. The loss in funding for government services for just one uncounted person in Broward County was estimated at \$1,300 by the 2000 Census Monitoring board. An undercounting of 1,000 residents means a loss in funding for Broward County of \$1.3 million or more!
- Community organizations use census data to develop social service programs, community action projects, senior lunch programs and child care centers, and businesses use census data to identify where to locate factories, shopping centers, movie theaters, banks and offices – activities that lead to new jobs!
