Reminder that Priority Registration Applications for Summer School and Fall must be turned in by March 4th at the very latest for priority accommodations. Priority Registration is for our current students and their siblings for the Summer School and Fall programs. You should have already received an email with the Priority Registration instructions and dates for Summer and Fall, as well as the new tuition rate sheet. The instructions are also posted on our website under the Priority Registration section if you need to take a look at them. The system that we use for registrations on our website, has not updated its re-registration format, so we will do actual paper registrations that will need to be submitted to the school for processing. The applications should have been emailed to you already and you will need to print them out and bring them to the office by March 4th. Hard copies are available in the office for those without a printer. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Once we have processed your application, you will receive a bill with Registration Fees/ Summer Deposits that are due. As a reminder, your space is not guaranteed until all payments have been received. Open Registration to the Public will be held on March 30th, at which time we will be giving out remaining spaces.

Our Easter Party will be on Friday, April 3rd. The Pre-Kindergarten (Happy Hippos, Groovy Goldfish, Funky Foxes and Excellent Eagles) will walk to Lomita Park and have their party. The rest of the students will celebrate here at school. The Easter Bunny will be stopping by to visit during the parties. Children who do not normally attend on Fridays may attend as long as accompanied by an adult (Please check the wall by the fish tank for times and more information, or see the office with any questions) Pre K Parent helpers will be needed for this busy day. We will be asking for treat donations. If you are interested in bringing in treats, or volunteering, please check the sign-ups by the fish tank.

REMINDERS:

When dropping students off in the morning, please take them to the area where the teachers are. Students may not be left in any empty classroom or in the hallways unattended. Please always let a teacher know that the student has arrived and that you are leaving for the day.

Please make sure that you are labeling all of your child's belongings. This includes jackets, extra clothes, lunch utensils and cups, blankets, etc. When things are misplaced, it is much easier for us to find the correct owners when items are clearly labeled.

If you are sending any lunch items with your students that need to be warmed up, please be sure to send them in their own microwave safe container for easy heating.

If there are students with a teacher using the children's restroom by the front door, please refrain from entering the restroom with your child to wash up or have them use the restroom.
