

A Local Law To Expand the Town of Cohocton Ambulance District into the Village of Cohocton Pursuant to Town Law §190

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cohocton as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Cohocton to consent to the extension of the Town of Cohocton Ambulance District by local law, pursuant to and as defined by Town Law §190.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to Town Law §190, which expressly authorizes the consent of a village expressed in a local law or by resolution of the board of trustees and not subject to any referendum to the establishment or extension of a town special district, including an ambulance district, to wholly or partly within an incorporated village.

Section 3. Establishment and Extension of Town of Cohocton Ambulance District into the Whole of the Village of Cohocton

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Cohocton, County of Steuben, is hereby authorized to consent, and does hereby consent, to the establishment and extension of the Cohocton Ambulance District into the whole of the Village of Cohocton upon the creation of such ambulance district by the Town of Cohocton.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
