DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

Emergency Medical Responder (47-531-400)

This 70-hour course is based upon the US DOT National Standard Curriculum, but contains additional skills and competencies used by Emergency Medical Responders (EMR) in Wisconsin. This course includes, advanced skills approved for the EMR and the American Heart Association Health Care Provider Basic Life Support CPR. After successful completion of the course, a National Registry of EMT’s – Registered Emergency Medical Responder exam is required to obtain your license.

Emergency Medical Technician (10-531-940) - Must complete the Admissions requirements to be eligible to enroll.

Based upon the State of Wisconsin/U.S. Department of Transportation/National Highway Transportation Safety Administration curriculum, this 185-hour program includes classroom instruction—lectures, discussion, demonstrations, skill practice and an additional patient care experience, which requires a minimum of ten patient care contacts.
