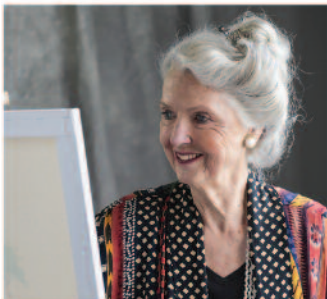

Welcome to Pooler, Georgia

In December 1864 as William Sherman moved in on Savannah, he found that even though a scant ten miles away, it may as well have been a thousand. He and his men had their work cut out for them, and their journey would be grueling.

You see, General Sherman promised to "give Savannah to President Lincoln for a Christmas present", and Christmas was fast approaching. With this in mind, his group of exhausted Yankees pitched a camp astride the Central of Georgia Railway at Pooler Station that cold December 9, 1864. Sherman stepped out of his headquarters tent, 300 yards west of the station and peered down the long, straight stretch of rails into the very heart of this seaside city of Savannah. There were perhaps less than 200 war-wearied souls in this lonely, impoverished community of Pooler and neither they nor the General could envision the Pooler that is in existence today.

Our city was named after Robert William Pooler in 1838. A resident of Savannah, Pooler worked for the Central of Georgia Railroad. William W. Gordon, President of the Central of Georgia, recognized and admired Pooler's strong work ethic and the long hours he spent to establish a "feasibility" study of the towns and counties through which a proposed railroad would extend. In appreciation he named the first station west of Savannah after him. Born the same year, 1796, Gordon and Pooler were both graduate law and engineering students, and each took a prominent part in the civic and military affairs of Savannah.

For several decades after the Civil War, this young community, and all of Georgia, was stunned by the devastation. Gradually, the South caught its breath in a new birth. Around 1883, Ben Rothwell, bought several hundred acres in the community and pioneered a new method of community development by giving free lots to builders of permanent homes.

A sawmill was built to supply lumber to homebuilders and the embryonic community began to take shape. The brickyard supplied other needed materials and dairies soon found a ready market. Remains of the brickyard can be found near the railroad tracks just south of what is now I-95.

Near the turn of the century, Dr. William Blakely served the community as a real "country doctor". He might have been seen during the winter knocking on doors, advising mothers to hang a bag of asafetida around the children's necks to ward off the croup, whooping cough, etc. He was a beloved character and a line of children followed his mule-drawn wagon as it carried his body to the cemetery.

In these early years, a favorite gathering spot was a soda fountain and drug store operated by Joe Heidt on Main Street. The Pooler Rifle Club, one of the first organizations in town, provided some protection, as there was no police patrol here. It later became a Sportsman Club.

Incorporated in 1907, Pooler's first mayor was H.G. Beaufort. Soon after Mrs. Gary Goggins became the first woman to vote in the State of Georgia. She also was the only woman alderman for the Town of Pooler. In 1923 a town hall was erected as a permanent place to transact municipal business.

The town rapidly grew with the establishment of banks, automobile service stations, repair shops and restaurants. The opening of Interstate 95 attracted more shops and industries to the City of Pooler and nearby areas.

Steeped in history, Pooler has built a solid foundation of responsible growth. As we move forward, our city will continue to provide visitors, residents and newcomers with excellent living, recreational, cultural and business opportunities.

Tanger Outlet Mall with more than 90 upscale stores. The area also offers a wide range of outdoor activities such as golf, tennis, boating and hiking. The nearby coastline is peppered with fascinating islands which make for delightful side trips.

For those who plan to call Pooler home, our lovely and affordable city is a mecca for retirees. However, they're not the only ones seeking a gentler lifestyle. Stressed-out city dwellers, who are still in the work force and tired of long commutes, are heading this direction. In addition to many new businesses in the area, advanced telecommunications and e-commerce provide opportunities for many to earn their livings here and experience a higher quality of life. With a relatively high household median income, the influx of newcomers to the Pooler area is spurring its economic and cultural growth. This translates to a better educated and more affluent population with solid purchasing power for goods and services.

Sometimes it's the quiet little southern towns we travel through that grab our attention and make us want to stay for awhile – maybe forever. So before you head on down the road, sit for a spell under the shade of a large magnolia, listen to the chirping of the cicadas, sip a little sweet tea and enjoy the quiet charm of Pooler. Like so many others before you, you may decide to never leave.

Greetings to All!

The year 2018 is just beginning, but there's already much excitement as Pooler anticipates another year of positive growth. You probably have noticed that we have attracted many new businesses to the area that are impressed not only by the economic opportunities here, but also by the beauty of Pooler. At our Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Bureau, we enjoy participating in the many ribbon cuttings, ground breakings and grand opening events and want to share our enthusiasm for our city's new and already existing high quality businesses that provide state-of-the-art products and services.

Pooler has more than 1,000 businesses to choose from and below are a few examples of those whose vision and high-tech advances are enhancing the welfare and safety of our community.

The Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) broke ground in Pooler last summer for the new Coastal Crime Laboratory. Estimating that the coastal area's population will grow to over a million by 2030, the large capacity 66,000 square-foot facility will replace the much smaller building. The project should be completed sometime this year.

Police departments in our area rely on the GBI's Coastal crime lab which processes various types of forensics for death and criminal investigations. The new lab will allow easier access for law enforcement personnel which translates to faster turnaround time for forensic services.

Our city's well-qualified and well-trained Police and Fire Department appreciate the more efficient crime-solving methods which contribute to Pooler's reputation for being one of the safest towns in Georgia. The departments take pride that in 2016 and 2017, Pooler has been a recipient of Safest Cities in Georgia, a report published by Safewise.

We also are very excited that St. Joseph's/Candler plans to build a "micro hospital" system in Pooler. This system provides an innovative shift in medical care from traditional in-patient services that involve longer hospital stays to more out-patient services such as non-invasive procedures. The first phase scheduled to open in early 2019 begins a 10-year plan to create a 170,000-square-foot, multi-story, technologically advanced medical facility.

St. Joseph's/Candler is also in the process of expanding St. Joseph's Hospital. The plan includes upgrades to the outpatient surgery and imaging departments and ambulance entrance. It will be followed by a renovation of the former emergency department.

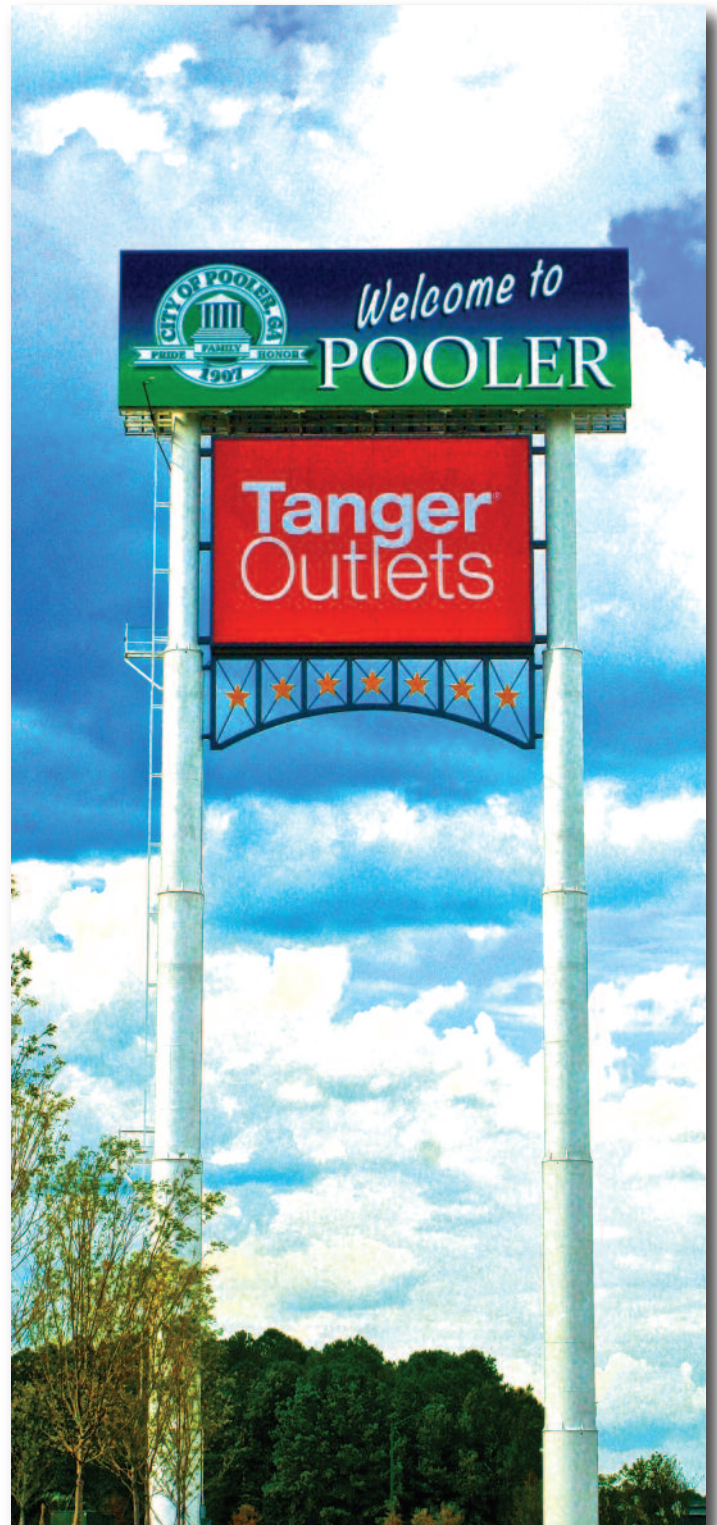

On behalf of the dedicated men and women who serve as firefighters for the City of Pooler, I would like to welcome you and thank you for considering our wonderful city. The City of Pooler Department of Fire-Rescue Services is one of the best equipped and trained departments in Georgia. The department has a staff of 59 personnel providing administrative functions, fire suppression, rescue response, emergency medical treatment, and fire prevention activities. We provide coverage to all residents within the city limits of Pooler as well as several contract areas located within unincorporated Chatham County. Our total coverage area encompasses a little over 30 square miles.

Pooler Fire-Rescue serves one of the fastest growing communities in the state of Georgia. Pooler's population has more than tripled since the 2000 census, and according to the 2015 estimate 23,133 people reside in the city and an additional 2,000 are protected in our contracted areas. Pooler, Georgia was incorporated in 1907, and the Fire Department was first recognized by a city ordinance on June 13, 1950.

Not only has the city experienced significant growth, but also the Fire Department has undergone quite an expansion over the last two decades. The department added its Fire Chief to the payroll in 1999, by May 2008 a second station had been built and 16 career firefighters as well as 12 volunteers were serving the community. Fast forward to 2016 and the department has transformed into an almost fully career department with 59 paid employees.

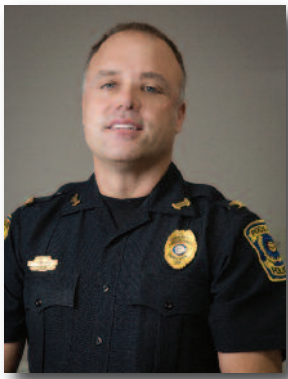
There are now four stations staffed and in operation throughout the city, with four engines and an aerial ladder truck staffed with a minimum of three personnel on duty at all times. Construction was just completed to replace our Headquarters station, and plans calling for station 5 are in place. New construction to start later this year as growth continues through the city. The department maintains an impressive inventory of fire and rescue equipment that enables us to safely and efficiently do our job. There are five firefighting engines, two aerial ladder trucks, a heavy rescue squad, a 75' quint, a 3,500-gallon water tanker truck, a state sponsored search and rescue truck and three command vehicles. We just received an order of four new fire engines and a new aerial ladder that will combine our heavy rescue and one aerial into a single unit. The department also has automatic assistance and mutual aid agreements with Garden City, the City of Savannah and Port Wentworth in the event additional equipment and personnel are needed.

Pooler Fire-Rescue is a full-service fire department that has the capability to respond to any type of fire, rescue and/or medical emergency. We offer more to the community than emergency response. We also provide home safety inspections, commercial building pre-fire planning, fire hydrant inspection, and blood pressure checks. Fire prevention activities complete with fire safety clowns are offered to local schools, and static fire apparatus displays, station tours and safety demonstrations can be requested for community activities.

The Pooler Fire-Rescue Department is a State Certified Agency that complies with all state approved standards and with all policies and regulations, and is one of the best-trained and equipped fire departments in the region. The City of Pooler Police Department has been in operation since 1950. The department is a state certified agency that adheres to rigorous state approved standards. As the City of Pooler becomes one of the fastest growing communities in Georgia, the Police Department continues to grow as well. At the moment, there are forty-nine officers employed by the city, as well as various support personnel. Their efforts became evident when Pooler was named in the SafeWise Report (the authority on safety and home security news) in the top 50 Safest Cities in Georgia for 2017, 2016, and 2015.

The dedicated and professional officers of the Pooler Police Department are committed to providing the highest quality of law enforcement to the community. Police Chief Mark Renew says, "The Pooler Police Department is family oriented, meaning their purpose is to make sure that Pooler remains a great place to raise a family." He strongly encourages his officers to reside in Pooler, saying "it's important that they interact and get to know the residents and business employees professionally and personally."

"Despite being the epicenter for growth in the Southeast, our department offers several services to maintain that small-town charm." Neighborhood watches can be organized with the aid of the Police Department. "We will educate the residents on the importance of neighborhood watches and how they make for a better community." The majority of Pooler is designed to encourage socializing and walking. The city has also become a golf cart friendly-community and the Police Department offers golf cart registration.

The traffic officers of the Pooler Police Department provide bike safety fairs at the local elementary schools where students are taught the importance of bike safety. They also regularly patrol roadways where school zones are located to ensure the safety of the community's children.

Chief Renew credits much of the reduction in crime rates to the hard work of his patrol officers and the recent establishment of the Crime Suppression Unit in late 2015. This new unit is designed to focus on the prevention of crimes such as shoplifting and entering autos. The unit maintains high visibility and concentrates on areas subject to these crimes such as busy shopping centers.

The Pooler Police Department actively supports and respects the military. Reaching out and making deployments easier for the families left behind, and supporting those who have been wounded is important to the department.
