- 16:3 Commit your works to the Lord and your plans will be established.

- 24:8-9a He who plans to do evil, men will call him a schemer. The devising of folly is sin.
- Don't brag about your plans for 27:1 tomorrow - wait and see what happens (LB)
- 27:12 A sensible man watches for problems ahead, and prepares to meet them. A simpleton never looks, and suffers the consequences (LB).
- 4:25-26 Let your eyes look directly ahead, and let your gaze be fixed straight in front of you. Watch the path of your feet, and all your ways will be established.
