- -On a motion duly made by S. Johnson, seconded by S. Matto, through unanimous vote, the board approved landscape refurbishments requested by Lakewood Forest Garden Club; allocation to be taken from reserve account in accordance with reserve study.
- -On a motion duly made by S. Matto, seconded by S. Johnson, through unanimous vote, the board approved offsite storage at Lakewood Mini Storage for PVB covers, erosion materials & office overflow.
- -Discussion held regarding addition of blackberry bushes as deterrent for graffiti on exterior of patio lake perimeter wall; tabled for consultation with "Plants for All Seasons".
- -Grant Road wall discussion deferred to executive session.
- -On a motion duly made by S. Johnson, seconded by P. Marshall, through unanimous vote, the board approved the additional annual premium of \$4,141.00 in regards to statement of values adjustment based on reserve study numbers; total blanket amount increased from \$813,773 to \$1,776.473.
- -Board notified Lake Forest Utility District Board agreed to make a donation for the Dick Taylor Pond Erosion Point 8 endeaver in the amount of 20% of the actual project cost of the wall repairs, not to exceed \$1,000; donation received in the amount of \$873.77.
