



**Jacksonville Alumnae Panhellenic Association
Mary Louise Herr Memorial Scholarship – 2019
Award amount \$2,500.00**

The following is a list of requirements for the Mary Louise Herr Memorial Scholarship applicant:

1. The applicant must be a full-time student (carrying a minimum 12 hour course load) at either The University of North Florida or Jacksonville University.
2. The applicant must have completed a minimum of 75 credit hours of course work as of the date of this application.
3. The applicant must be a member in good standing of a Greek women's NPC organization on their campus.
4. The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (where an A is equal to 4.0).
5. Past recipients of the Mary Louise Herr Memorial Scholarship are ineligible to reapply.

The following items **must** be submitted along with the Mary Louise Herr Memorial Scholarship application:

1. An official **sealed** transcript of grades with the cumulative GPA for the applicant's entire college enrollment period.
2. A resume including, but not limited to, a listing of:
 - a. All universities/colleges attended and dates of attendance.
 - b. Sorority activities – including offices held, general descriptions of the duties of said offices, and any honors awarded.
 - c. Campus/Community Service/Volunteer activities – may include religious activities.
 - d. Employment history to include the dates of employment.
3. A recent photograph that may be used in a news release.

4. Three letters of recommendation:
 - a. One letter of recommendation **MUST** be from the Chapter Advisor of the applicant's sorority. The letter needs to explain about the applicant, her involvement within the sorority and on campus, as well as confirming that the applicant is in "Good Standing" with her sorority.
 - b. Suggested resources for the other two letters of recommendation are: teachers, guidance counselors, alumnae, or employers. Fellow collegians **may not** be used as resources for the letters of recommendation.
5. A brief statement indicating your major and the reasons for selecting that major. Specifically describe your educational goals, career plans, and how the award will assist you financially.
