



To the Parents/Guardians and Students of the 2018 Kids SmART Summer Program:

We are so excited that you have chosen Kids SmART as your child's summer camp! In order to ensure that the summer is exciting and fun-filled while also being safe, we have listed a few reminders for the parents below. PLEASE be sure to read this in its entirety as it is very important in helping assure the quality and safety of the program.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Mon-Fri 6:30am-6:00pm May 29- August 13. We will be closed July 4. Parents must physically come in and sign their children in/out each day not only for safety reasons, but also to allow for effective communication between the families and camp staff. We cannot accept children prior to 6:30am. Children picked up after 6:00pm will be charged \$1/minute that they are late.

CAMP LOCATIONS: Please note that whichever camp you register for is the one you are required to drop off and pick your child up at. See the camps monthly activity calendars for specific theme/Field Trip/Outreach information.

Lasley Elementary- 1401 S Kendall St Lakewood. In the cafeteria.

Rose Stein Elementary- 80 S Teller St Lakewood. In the cafeteria.

Columbian Elementary- 2925 W 40th Ave Denver. In rooms 100/101 (East entrance).

*Camp will be at Edgewater Elem. 5/29-6/1 (5570 W 24th Ave Edgewater)

Wilmore Davis – 7975 W 41st Ave Wheat Ridge, In Temp 5 at back of building

TUITION: EVERY PARENT is expected to fill out a tuition calendar stating the dates their children will be attending, and pay in advance. For those families on CCAP, you will still be expected to fill out a calendar and your monthly parent fee will be due by the 1st of every month. Remaining families are required to turn in payment with your tuition calendar every Wednesday for the upcoming Monday thru Friday. Advance payment is required. If you do not pay and schedule in advance, you will be considered a drop-in and will be charged the additional \$5/day/child drop-in fee (if we have space to care for your child). We recommend payment/schedules by the 25th of each month for the entire upcoming month's planned attendance as you will then receive a 10% discount off the tuition total. If you have scheduled your children and they will not be at camp, please call/text the camp phone to let us know not to expect them. You may pick up camp phone business cards on the first day of camp. There will not be credits or refunds for unattended scheduled days, although you do not have to pay for any days that you do not sign up for.

CCAP: CCAP families are responsible for tracking their attendance using the CCAP attendance tracking system (or card swiping, if CCAP has not yet transitioned). More details on this process will be provided once the CCAP transition to their new system is clear.

PARENT TABLE: Parents MUST check their children in and out every day on the tablets. Existing parents/guardians can continue to use their individual established PIN # to check in/out. New authorized pick-ups will need to establish new PIN #s. The children cannot sign themselves in or out, and PINs cannot be shared. Parents are expected to read the information on the parent table every day as well. This is how we will communicate important camp information to all of the parents about field trips, etc.

THINGS TO BRING EVERY DAY: *AM AND PM Snacks *Water Bottle

*Sunscreen (Banana Boat SPF 30/45)- Please purchase bottles that you can leave at camp for your child. **Please also put a coat of sunscreen on your children prior to their arrival to camp.**

LUNCH: We are extremely fortunate to be able to offer **free lunch** (and breakfast) for the campers for the majority of the summer. Your child is still welcome to bring their own lunch if they so desire.

FAMILIES are asked to bring sack lunches from 5/29-6/1 as we cannot provide meals prior to 6/4.

SWIMMING: Every Monday we will be going to various swimming pools to swim. Children are expected to wear their swimsuit under their clothes, and bring a change of clothes with them to change into after swimming. They are also expected to bring a towel. The pools we will be going to accommodate all swimming levels, so no need to worry about your child's swimming ability. If the pool is an outdoor pool, it is extremely important that you sunscreen them prior to coming to camp AND make sure they have sunscreen at camp to re-apply. Unless otherwise noted, the pools do not allow water toys so please leave those at home.

WHEELS DAY: Every Tuesday children are encouraged to bring their "wheels" with them to ride. They are required to bring the following pads with them as well: Bicycle or Scooter- Helmet; Rollerblades or skateboard- Helmet, elbow and knee pads. If they do not have all of the appropriate gear, they will NOT be allowed to ride. NO EXCEPTIONS. There will be no sharing of the wheels or protective gear allowed. Each child will be responsible for bringing their own bike lock, and Kids SmART is not responsible for lost/stolen bikes or equipment. No motorized wheels will be allowed.

FIELD TRIPS: Most Wednesdays we will be going on a field trip. Please be sure and check the parent table for specific field trip information so you get your child to camp on time, and know if you need to send your child with anything specific. We will walk and/or take a van to a few of the field trips, but for the most part we will transport in a Jefferson/Denver County School Bus. The cost of the field trip is included in your daily fee.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS: Children are allowed to bring personal belongings with them, provided that they have them properly labeled with their name and it is appropriate for camp. If the belonging causes any issues, it will be taken away and given to the parents at the time of pick-up. This policy includes cell phones- we understand the desire for you to stay in touch with your child throughout the day, but in the interest of all of their safety we reserve the right to confiscate their phones and return it upon their leaving camp. Kids SmART is not liable for lost/damaged items.
