

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 35**

**TOWNSHIP OF BLAIRSTOWN  
COUNTY OF WARREN  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 184 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BLAIRSTOWN TO ADD A NEW SECTION 184-30 ENTITLED "SPEED HUMPS"**

**WHEREAS**, the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of Police have reviewed the traffic conditions on certain streets throughout the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of Police have determined that speed humps are necessary as traffic calming measures on certain streets in the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Chief of Police have recommended the installation of speed humps on East Avenue and Main Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee, upon review of those recommendations and review of the Code, has determined that the Code must be revised to establish the Township's right to install such traffic calming measures; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Blairstown, Warren County, New Jersey, that Chapter 184 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" of the Code of the Township of Blairstown be and is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 184 "Vehicles and Traffic" shall be amended to add new Section 184-30 "Speed Humps" to read as follows:

**§184-30 Speed Humps.**

The following designated streets are approved for installation of speed humps in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-8.10 and 39:4-8.11:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Location</b>
East Avenue	Entire length
Main Street	Entire length

Such streets have been found to meet the following criteria:

- A. The streets are totally self-contained within the municipality and have no direct connection with any street in any other municipality or the streets are totally self-contained one-way streets that connect to a county road.
- B. The streets have a traffic volume under 3,000 vehicles per day.
- C. The streets have a posted speed limit of 30 miles per hour or less.

All other portions of this Chapter remain unchanged.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Blirstown inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This law shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
