

PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE ON PRAYER SHRINE DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY

El Santuario de Los Pobladores – The Sanctuary of the Settlers, invite supporters of this undertaking to stop by the site to see the progress made. Adobe walls are going up, a large beautiful rustic gate is adorning the entrance to the shrine with three smaller gates at the exits. Bronze art for the individual “nichos” is being mounted into individual sections of the Mysteries of the Rosary as they are completed. At the entrance to the shrine, there will be a 7 foot bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Seven surrounding bronze statues of our mission patron saints will bolster the spiritual presence of our faith. Adobe dedication plaques and merchant donor plaques will also be in place. Landscaping and a security system will complete the project. The committee estimates that additional funds to complete the project will be approximately \$250,000. MASS READING REFLECTION

August 14, 2022

First Reading

Jer 38: 4-6, 8-10

(Imprisonment of Jeremiah)

“Jeremiah the prophet (“spokesman of God”) corrected the power structure of his society. Israel was God’s chosen people, living with him in a sacred partnership (covenant). He wanted those in power to realize this, but they did not like to be corrected by the man of God.

This reading prepares us to understand today’s Gospel in which Jesus predicts his passion and death. Suffering and endurance are part of each serious Christian’s life, and faith in God should help us withstand them. “Though I am afflicted and poor, yet the LORD thinks of me.”

Second Reading

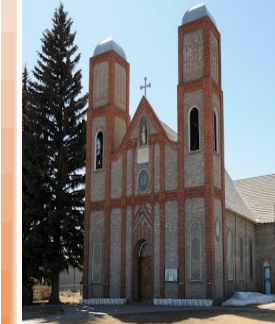
Heb 12:1-4

(Perseverance)

Whenever the ancient Romans built cities, one finds the ruins of an amphitheater. They loved the games. This passage uses sporting language to encourage us not to follow the easy way as Christians but rather to make even painful decisions, if necessary (Gospel). Life is the arena of the local amphitheater. A cloud of witnesses/spectators watches us. Sins are hindering clothes. Take them off when you are running.

Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus. As a good coach, he inspires and perfects your faith and self-confidence. And He give the reason for your efforts, namely, the joy of heaven. He himself endured the opposition of sinners (Gospel). The lesson for you and me is: Do not abandon the struggle!

LUKE 12:49 TPT

Theme: Can We Stand Correction?

“Leave me alone? Mind your own business!” is the usual reaction when others interfere with our way of life. We want to be happy in our own little world, with our good and perhaps also bad habits!

Children do not like to be corrected by parents or teachers. Grownups unduly resent their employers’ attempts to enhance their working methods. Parishioners may concede that priests should preach on sin but they do not want them to go into details in which the audience may be involved! And in the “closed society” of the South in the sixties, people who came in to encourage blacks to stand up for their rights were termed “outside agitators.” They were told: “Go home and leave us alone!”

Today’s Second Reading compares life with a race course. We should persevere in running the race of life. But no team is going to succeed without a coach who observes every player and corrects the technique of each. Can we stand honest corrections? The First Reading and Gospel tell us about Jeremiah and Jesus of Nazareth, who did not leave people alone. In the name of God, they had to speak. Their sermons were corrective and aimed at restoring life as it should be.
