"Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another-and all the more as you see the Day approaching."



The broken windows in the Fellowship Hall have also been replaced.


Tanner Addy's Eagle Scout Project is underway! Posts and placement has begun. Come by and look at the progress. We will dedicate the space soon.


