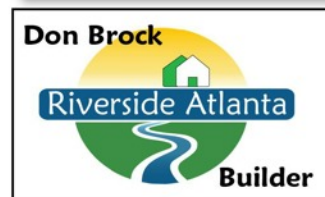
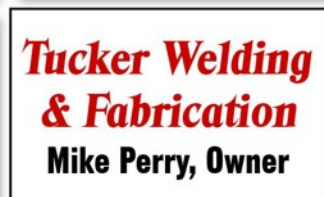
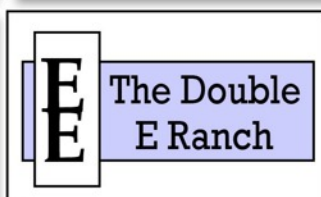
Here is a GREAT opportunity to show off your "Cool" ride to a bunch of folks! PLUS visit one of the area's BEST Arts & Crafts Festivals.
