EXHIBIT A

WATERCRAFT STORAGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Watercraft has the same definition as Indiana Code Section 14-8-2-305 as any instrumentality or device in or by means of which a person may be transported upon the public water of Indiana. The term includes a motorboat, sailboat, rowboat, skiff, dinghy, or canoe of any length or size; and whether or not used to carry passengers for hire but does not include a Personal Watercraft, as defined in Indiana Code Section 14-8-2-202.5 as a watercraft whose primary source of motive power is an inboard motor powering a water jet pump; and that is designed to be operated by a person who sits, stands, or kneels on the surface of the watercraft rather than sitting or standing inside the watercraft. (See Section 91.03 (D) of the Municipal Code of the Town of Beverly Shores)
- 2. Personal Watercrafts are prohibited on the Town of Beverly Shores' beaches and may not be stored on the Beach Storage Areas.
- 3. The Watercraft must be stored in the Boat Storage Area.
- 4. No Watercraft may be connected to or tethered to stairs or trees.
- 5. Watercraft shall be tethered or anchored to the ground to prevent it from blowing over.
- 6. No items of personal property may be connected or tethered to the ground, stairs, trees or other object, except for a boat box that is no larger than 3' wide x 3' feet high x 5' long may be tethered to the ground provided that it is located under and completely within the confines of the Watercraft.
