<p><b>#1 - Constitutional Amendment (voter referendum);</b> personal property tax exemption; motor vehicle owned by a veteran who is disabled. Provides for a voter referendum at the Nov 3, 2020 election to approve or reject a personal property tax exemption for a vehicle that is owned and used primarily by or for a veteran who has a one hundred percent service-connected, permanent, and total disability. <i>These bills <b>MUST PASS, BE RECONCILED, AND SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR</b> or the Constitutional Amendment must be reintroduced in in 2021 to restart the Constitutional Amendment Process which will require 2 more years.</i></p>	<p>HB 1268 Helmer HJ 103 Helmer</p>	<p>SB 446 Reeves SJ 33 Reeves SB 820 Morrissey SJ 58 Morrissey</p>
<p><b>#2 - Absentee Voting;</b> counting Military and overseas absentee ballots that are received after the close of the polls on any election day but received before 5:00p.m. on the second business day before the State Board of Elections meets to ascertain the results of the election and are postmarked on or before the day if the election.</p>	<p>HB 203 Tran, JCole</p>	<p>SB 455 Reeves</p>
<p><b>#3 - Income Tax;</b> provides a subtraction for the military retirement pay received by certain low-income military veterans who have been rated with a 100% service connected permanent and total disability.</p>	<p>HB 125 Miyares HB 1619 Helmer</p>	<p>SB 456 Reeves</p>
<p><b>#4 - Virginia National Guard;</b> state active duty for emergency response; pay and allowances for members. Provides that whenever called to state active duty members of the National Guard and the Virginia Defense Force receive the pay and allowance to their rank and years of service. <p><b>#5 - Income tax, state and corporate tax credit;</b> employers of National Guard members and self-employed National Guard members. Provides a nonrefundable tax credit against individual and corporate income taxes for (i) wages payed to a National Guard member, (ii) additional provision as to amounts of credits and days of eligibility.</p>	<p>HB 1620 Helmer HB 230 Freitas</p>	<p>SB 218 Suetterlein SB 753 Reeves</p>
<p><b>#6 - Microloans for Veterans Program and Fund;</b> creation and administration. Creates the Microloan for Veterans Program to be administered by the Virginia Small Business Financing Authority. Establishes 2 tiers of loan amounts and eligibility requirements for each tier.</p>		<p>SB 458 Reeves</p>
