This presentation will present an overview of what's occurring with medical and recreational laws, advice for employers on the issue, and what trends we will see going forward. Issues for employers with legalized recreational marijuana in California will be discussed.

Dr. Tamara Cagney has provided Employee Assistance Program (EAP) services for over 35 years in both the public and private sectors, in unionized and non-unionized settings. Since 2000 she has been an internal EA professional at Sandia National Laboratories. She also provides ongoing clinical consultation to the Northern California Teamsters' Assistance Program. She is currently President of the Employee Assistance Professionals Association.
