Mark your calendars to join us on Saturday, December 7th at 7:30 am for a great breakfast and a time of prayer and devotion. And bring a friend!

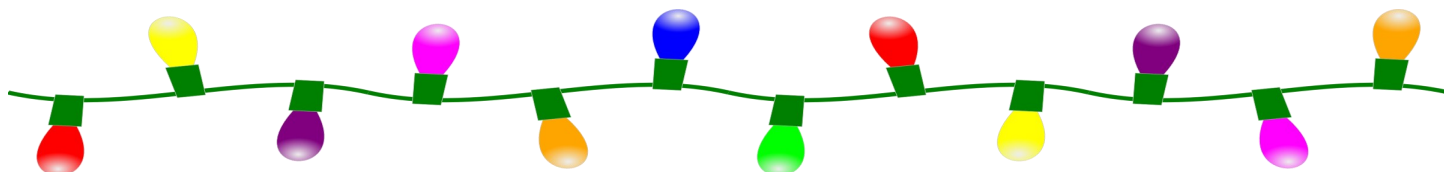
Secret Sister Reveal
