Coral Community Charter (CCC) is a state approved charter school and the first in the state of New Mexico to offer single-gender classes. CCC is dedicated to providing single-gender classes, quality instruction, individualization and family/community involvement in order to ensure students' proficiency. CCC Governance Council (GC)

GC members are responsible for ensuring the academic program of CCC is successful, the school's program and operation are faithful to the terms of its charter, and the school is a viable organization. The purpose of the GC is to set the general direction and policy of the school, not manage it on a daily basis. The GC member has no individual authority; it is only as a collective board that there is authority.

The successful GC candidate is required to regularly attend meetings which are held monthly. Currently they are held on the last Tuesday of the month and generally last about 1 ½ hours. On occasion, special or emergency meetings may be called to address specific issues. In addition to attending the monthly board meetings, each member serves on a committee which requires a few extra hours of work outside of the monthly meeting. The new member must complete yearly GC training held in the fall. Five hours of yearly training is required by state law. The GC is made up of members from the community and have experience in various fields and three parent members. Currently areas of expertise represented on the GC include accounting, law, business, and education. The GC position is held for two years, and is a chance to be involved in the education of our future generation. It is a time commitment of about 5-8 hours per month.
