Our Color Guard wears the Marine Corps League authorized Undress Uniform: white short sleeve aviator shirt with appropriate shoulder patches; khaki belt; USMC NCO trousers (non-NCO trousers for Associate members.) Hi-Gloss Black Oxford shoes, red MCL cover. In cool weather, we wear the embroidered red Rawlings Coach's Jacket. In cold weather the Rothco MA-1 Flight Jacket becomes the outerwear. The Undress Uniform is only authorized to be worn while operating as a Color Guard or Honor Guard. MCL or DOD ribbons can be worn with the uniform, but either one or the other, not mixed.
