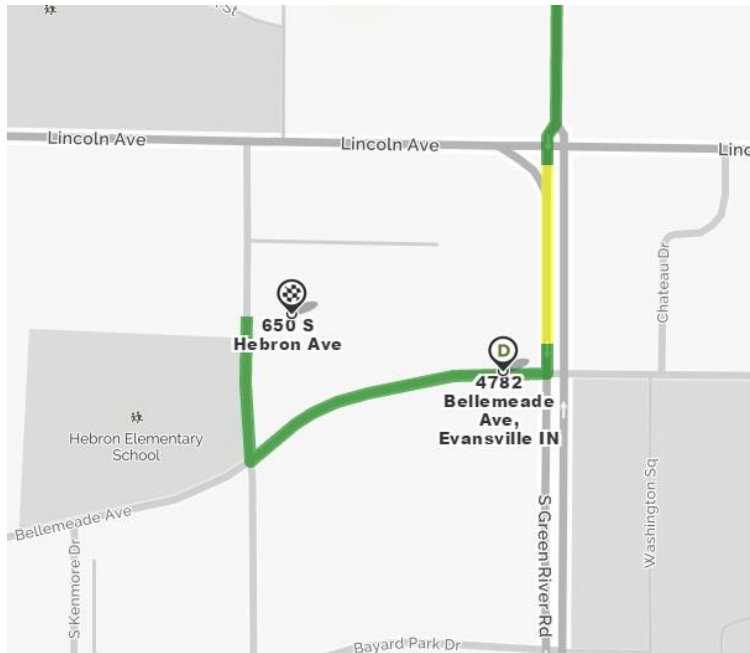
Future Meetings:
