


Wheat

Seeding Date, Methods & Rate

Seeding Rate: 100# per acre
August-October (Early is Best)

Burndown

Kill wheat with a grass herbicide or by plowing, disking or mowing before seed matures.

Expectations

Winter wheat, a winter annual cereal, is increasingly grown instead of rye because it is cheaper and easier to manage in the spring. It is one of the easiest cover crops to grow, and is usually relatively cheap. Wheat is a good choice to mix with crimson clover. The clover provides nitrogen and compliments wheat to cover the soil surface and suppress weeds. Wheat can be grown for seed production as well as for residue. Corn after Wheat is not recommended.
