## **ORDINANCE 312**

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 191 CONCERNING THE CONTROL, REGISTRATION, KEEPING OF ANIMALS AND FOWL WITHIN THE CITY OF WALTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED:

ARTICLE 1-112 Shall be amended to read:

"Properly licensed veterinary hospitals are excluded from the provisions of this article. No provision of this ordinance shall apply to a public school, which is maintaining domestic animals as part of the school curriculum."

The Citizens of Walton are allowed to deliver unwanted animals to Caring Hands Humane Society. The charges for delivery of the unwanted animals shall be paid by the City of Walton with reimbursement to the City coming from the person delivering the unwanted animal. The failure to pay for the reimbursement to the City shall result in the cost become a lien on their real estate and shall be certified to the County Treasurer for payment along with their real property tax statement or included as part of their monthly utility bill if they do not own real estate in the City of Walton.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the Newton Kansan, the official newspaper of the city of Walton, Kansas.
