TOUR OPTIONS

Civil Heritage Tour

The **Civil Heritage Trail** takes you all over Downtown Montgomery, Alabama and links historic sites that are related to the Civil War or the Civil Rights Movement. You will visit the **Museum of**



Alabama, located inside the **Alabama Department of Archives & History**, which features all new exhibits that tell the story of Alabama. Enjoy lunch at **Chris' Hotdogs**—a World famous, 100 year-old landmark. You will tour the **First White House of the Confederacy**, the Executive Residence of President Jefferson Davis and family while the capitol of the Confederacy was in Montgomery, Alabama. You will get to spend



time in the **Rosa Parks Museum**, which is an active memorial to the life of civil rights icon Rosa Parks and the lessons of the Montgomery Bus Boycott that brought racial integration to transportation and international attention to civil rights. Finally, you will tour the **Alabama State Capitol** and visit the spot where Jefferson Davis took the oath of office as President of the Confederate States of America and where the Civil Rights March ended.



Cost - \$45.00 per person (includes lunch)

Cotton Tour

The **Cotton Tour** will get you up close and personal with cotton farming. It will take you through the various processes of cotton production. You will visit the **EV Smith Research Center** to learn about the latest research in cotton farming and you will get to see, touch, and experience cotton growing in the field. You will also visit **Milstead Gin**—one of the area's largest cotton gins and see the inner workings of how



cotton gets from the farm to the end user. You will learn how Eli Whitney's invention to process raw cotton still works today. **UPDATE: The Wednesday and Friday tours are full, but we have added an additional tour on Thursday morning.**

Old Alabama Town Tour

There are no facades or newly constructed buildings here! The Old Alabama Town village features completely authentic 19th and early 20th century homes and buildings that have been saved from demolition, carefully



restored, and reopened to the public as a history museum. At Old Alabama Town, you will learn how early Americans of all backgrounds lived and worked in Central Alabama. The **Old Alabama Town Working Block** offers visitors the opportunity to see how the people of Alabama earned their living in both the rural and urban communities. An educational interpreter will take you back to the days of our Blacksmiths, Cotton Gins, and Grist Mills. The unique outdoor history museum is a place where people have fun learning about Central Alabama's history, architecture and lifestyle.

The Legends Tour

The **Fitzgerald Museum** is the only museum in the world dedicated to the lives of legends F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald. Their names invoke images of flappers, reckless spending, and gleaming hotel lobbies. In his novels and many short stories, Scott captured something essential about America.



The Great Gatsby is often cited as the finest novel of all time. Together, Scott and Zelda became icons of the Jazz Age.

You will also visit a museum dedicated to the great country legend, **Hank Williams, Sr.** Six decades after his death, Hank is still one of the most powerful, iconic figures in American music. Come and visit the place where the man who left his mark on the musical world, will inevitably leave his mark on you. You can also stroll the "Alley Entertainment District" and have a wonderful photo op at the statue of Hank Williams.



Cost - \$40.00 per person

Gene Jones Antique Museum

Nestled among the pine trees in the quiet community of Millbrook, Alabama is Gene Jones' Antique Museum and **Indian Artifact collection**. Enjoy a stroll among antique tractors, tools, horse/mule pull plows, a pedal tractor collection, see thousands of arrowheads and view the largest private collection of Native American Indian artifacts.
