

# ARE WE READY?

For what, we may ask.

The November Sunday readings at Mass call our attention to the end times - - death, judgment, heaven and hell. These realities may raise some questions in our minds.

For example, how prepared are we to respond when God calls our names at the time of death? Are there things that need to be done? What are they? Do we need to forgive someone for something? Do we need to seek forgiveness from another? Do we need to show others how much they mean to us? Do we need to make peace with God? Are there acts of charity I would like to do? Is there something I want to do before I die? What is it?

We can ask the same kinds of questions about our earthly affairs. Do I have a Living Will with someone appointed as a Durable Power of Attorney to carry it out? Do I have a Will that specifies the final disposal of my possessions?

Some people will even go farther to procure a grave site or to plan their funeral arrangements, including their funeral liturgy. Some will even pre-pay so as not to be a burden on family members. An attorney and a funeral director of your choice will be able to assist you by answering your questions and providing the help you seek.

While some people will not even hear of such matters, others have found that it makes sense for them and their family. Some have found a value just in the discussion that these matters create; some have found a sense of peace in tending to their details in a non-crisis situation. Once completed, these matters can be set aside, and we are free to "get on with life."

Some people feel that this is excellent advice for Senior Citizens. Death, however, is an inevitable fact of life, and as Scripture reminds us, no one knows the day or the hour. Will we be prepared?

St. Joseph, patron of a happy death, pray for us!
