Article 01 Town Officers

To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year. The business meeting will reconvene at 12:00 Noon, March 16th at the Town Hall for the continuation of business. Motion to continue the meeting.

Article 02 To receive reports of Town Officers

To receive reports of Town Officers and take action thereon.

Article 03 Operating Budget

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,202,463 for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. (Majority vote required)

Article 04 Well Monitoring

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$16,000 to be added to the Landfill Well Monitoring Capital Reserve previously established. (Majority vote required.) Selectmen Recommend.

Article 05 Vehicle shed for Highway

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000 to continue construction of a vehicle shed for the Highway department. (Majority vote required)

Article 06 Bridges

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000 to be added to the Bridges Capital Reserve Fund previously established. Selectmen Recommend.

Article 07 Fire Dept. Vehicle Maint.

To see if the town will vote to establish a Fire Department Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for vehicle maintenance and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be placed in this fund. Further, to name the Selectmen as agents to expend from said fund. Selectmen Recommend.

Article 08 Tractor & Trailer

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9,500 for the purpose of purchasing a tractor and trailer for the Parks and Recreation/Cemetery Department. (Majority vote required)

Article 09 Roads and Maintenance

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$200,000 to add to the Roads & Bridges Maintenance Capital Reserve Fund for long-term maintenance of roads and bridges with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. (Majority vote required) Selectmen Recommend

Article 10 Reconstruction of Center Road

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300,000 for the purpose of the reconstruction of Center Road. (Majority vote required)



Article 11 Highway Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000 to be added to the Highway Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund previously established. Selectmen Recommend.

Article 12 Vital Records

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500 for the purpose of adding to the Vital Records Restoration Expendable Trust Fund .(Majority vote required) Selectmen Recommend

Article 13 To transact any other business

To transact any other business as may come before said meeting.
