"What we BELIEVE Determines who we Become"

I did a Google Image search on "Believe in" and came up with some interesting results. By far the most frequent post was "believe in YOURSELF". Not surprising. Back in the 60s when I played little league and played saxophone in the junior high band I don't remember being encouraged to "believe in yourself" so I could become a great ball player or musician, instead I remember being instructed to "follow my instructions" and "work hard" for the sake of the team.

That cultural focus has been changing ever since. "Believe in Your Dreams" was the next most frequent post. That seems scary to me. I don't know about you but I've had some really weird and self serving dreams in my life. As I think back on them now I praise God I didn't "Believe in" my dreams so much that I would have devoted my life to them. Believe in "miracles" and "hope because miracles happen everyday" are two more of the most popular posts. So we "Believe in" dreams and miracles and hope as if they were things within themselves that we should believe in them?

When we as a people move away from Believing in the God of the Bible we are free to believe in; "everything", "nothing", "it", "me", "science"... anything our heart desires because we Believe in our self most. Isn't what we "Believe in" most what we worship? Have we not become a people of many gods?

What are you teaching your children, what are you passing down to the next generations, what legacy will you be leaving?

"What we Believe determines what we become" is a foundational statement in the church wide curriculum "Believe" we started Sept. 10th. I will use it as the source material for the sermon and we will use it in every Christian education class on Sundays and Wednesdays.

Each of the 30 lessons uses both Old and New Testament stories to answer a question. The first 10 focuses on "What Do I Believe?", the next 10 focuses on "What should I do?" and the last 10 "Who am I becoming". They focus on what we "Think", what we "Do" and who we are to, "Be".

Before we can fulfill Christ's mandate to "go and make disciples" we must know what to "Believe". Come and join us in our journey of discovery of the one true God, the God of the Bible.
