FERAL CATS in the ANCHORAGE NEIGHBORHOOD

Some neighbors might be aware of several Feral cats roaming the neighborhood and maybe some of you have put food out for them. Feeding Feral cats does not fix the problem.

These Feral cats breed and the kittens are able to reproduce more kittens within 4/5 months.

It would not be long before we could be overrun with wild cats, which is not a good thing.

There is an enormous growing population of free roaming wild cats posing a threat to the State's native animal species and birds.

Luckily there is a pilot program run by Pinellas County combined with a "Not for Profit Organization" called Meow Now.

For a modest fee of \$35. They will assist with a TNVR program. Trap/ Neuter/Vaccinate and Release.

One of our Neighbors, Janet Blank at 801 Leeward Way, was successful in trapping a Feral Siamese male cat recently. He had fathered a couple of kittens with a Feral female tabby. Not sure what happened to them but believe they probably perished as I haven't seen them around.

They were living in a storm drain. The male Siamese cat had a nasty injury on his back so Janet took him to her local Veterinarian.

He was tested for feline leukemia and proved negative. Poor boyhe needed 50 stitches to repair the injury on his back. He was then neutered and vaccinated. His ear was tipped (or notched) which indicates a wild cat has been neutered.

If some cat or animal lover has a few dollars to donate to Janet to cover her huge bill for treating this local cat I am sure she will be very appreciative.

Even just \$5 or \$10 would be gratefully received. It can all add up,
